The UC Regents and the CSU Trustees plan to raise student fees again (at UC by more than \$9000 over 4 years) at the same time that they continue to layoff workers and reduce their benefits. *Enough is enough.*

The salaries of UC executives continue to soar as do the monies available for outside consultants, from Public Relations at Office of the President to multi-million-dollar contracts to consultants who reorganize away unionized jobs, allegedly to save money, but in reality to reduce services.

Now the Regents are going after employee retirement benefits and plan to demolish the system that attracted career employees to UC for the last fifty years. With students facing a future of indentured servitude due to debt and workers facing poverty in retirement, we will be standing up together to stop the MADNESS of these unfair policies. ***UC Regents and the CSU Trustees are part of the 1% who benefit from these policies.***
